Moderator Instructions and Script

Black bold words: Pre-round helpful instructions for you

Red bold words: Script to say out loud

Black italic words: Actions to perform during round

Your Supplies:

- In your room, you will have six (6) copies of the case booklet (one for each judge, one for yourself, and one for each team), a pad of paper, pens, a dry-erase marker, and eraser. Note: only the paper provided in the room may be used for the competition.
- In your moderator packet (yellow envelope) you will have the following:
 - one (1) copy of the moderator script
 - three (3) copies of the score criteria (one for each judge)
 - o a matchup schedule
 - o a stopwatch to keep time

- o a coin to flip to determine which team goes first
- team A and B tent cards
- o a calculator to double-check the judges' scoring at the end of each round
- o a pen
- o time warning signs (1, 2, 3-minutes sign)
- Each round a red envelope will be delivered with the three (3) score sheets for the judges for that particular round and a gold card with the case and question for Team A and Team B for that round. **Do not share this information with anyone until indicated in this script.**
- A room assistant will be present with you in case you are missing any supplies or have any immediate questions or concerns for ethics bowl headquarters.

Before you start, familiarize yourself with the following guidelines and rules:

- Teams, coaches, judges, and spectators will enter the room shortly before the round starts.
- Give judges the score sheet and the score criteria and ask them to write their names and round number in the appropriate spots on the score sheet
- Teams should be seated at the tables with a maximum of five members on each team.
- Teams may use their own timer but it cannot be a cell phone, tablet, or anything else that stores data or can connect to the internet. They can only time their own sections—not the other team's.
 - ☐ Any watches that can access the internet cannot be worn (smartwatches, Apple watches, etc).
- ☐ Teachers, coaches, and non-participating team members should sit with spectators.
- Teams cannot substitute members, review notes, or confer with their coach once the round begins.
- Teams may have writing utensils (and approved timers) but nothing else until you give them scrap paper. Teams may not bring notes to the table.
